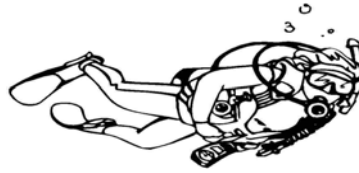

Dive site profile:

Virtus' primary itinerary focuses on diving in Komodo National Park which sits at the heart of the intersection between five major ocean currents, making it one of the most bio-diverse places in the world. The park is home to more than 1,000 species of fish, 385 species of reef building corals, 70 species of sponges, 10 dolphin species, six whale species, giant sea turtles, dugongs, and various species of sharks and rays. The underwater terrain ranges from thrilling vertical walls and pinnacles to tranquil sandy flats. The marine life provides a broad spectrum of experiences from heart-pounding encounters with mantas and other large pelagic down to the total satisfaction of spotting tiny pygmy seahorses. The diving coupled with the scenery through the "ring of fire" makes this one of the most exciting dive itineraries going. We will have an opportunity to visit the Komodo National Park as well as other "deserted" islands and beaches. In 1992 Komodo was declared a [World Heritage Site](#).

THE SHIP:

VIRTUS will re-define the luxury live-a-board market. The VIRTUS is a sturdy wooden motor sailor built in the traditional Pinisi style that measures 110 feet long and 24 feet wide. Sixteen crew members stand ready to pamper up to 12 live-a-board guests.
