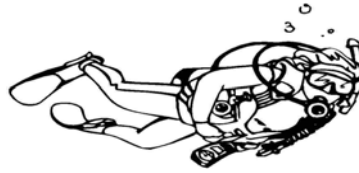

Dive site profile:

The island of Cozumel is the place of legends. Once an island capital for the eastern Mayan Empire. Cozumel's fame now lays in its diving, restaurants and nightlife. The island is located just off the eastern tip of the Yucatan peninsula in the Caribbean, and is blessed with a warm equatorial current which helps to support one of the most dramatic coral reefs in the world. Crystalline blue waters, in concert with a shear wall that extends for miles along the island's western coast, combine to attract divers from around the globe. Cozumel's attributes are undeniable. However, the best part of a trip to Cozumel is that it's a short 3 1/2 hour direct flight from Denver! June & July are the season for the whale shark migration through these waters. We are working on a optional program to snorkel with them!

Hotel:

Villa Blanca : is a small "boutique" garden hotel located approximately five miles from Cozumel Airport and two miles from town. Hotel amenities include a swimming pool, poolside bar, restaurant, and on-site dive shop. Services include valet laundry service, babysitting, and moped and bike rentals. Rooms have air-conditioning, ceiling fans, refrigerators, satellite TV, telephones, and all rooms have garden views. Rooms include either a king bed or two singles. This small property is immaculately clean and well located for beaches and restaurants.
